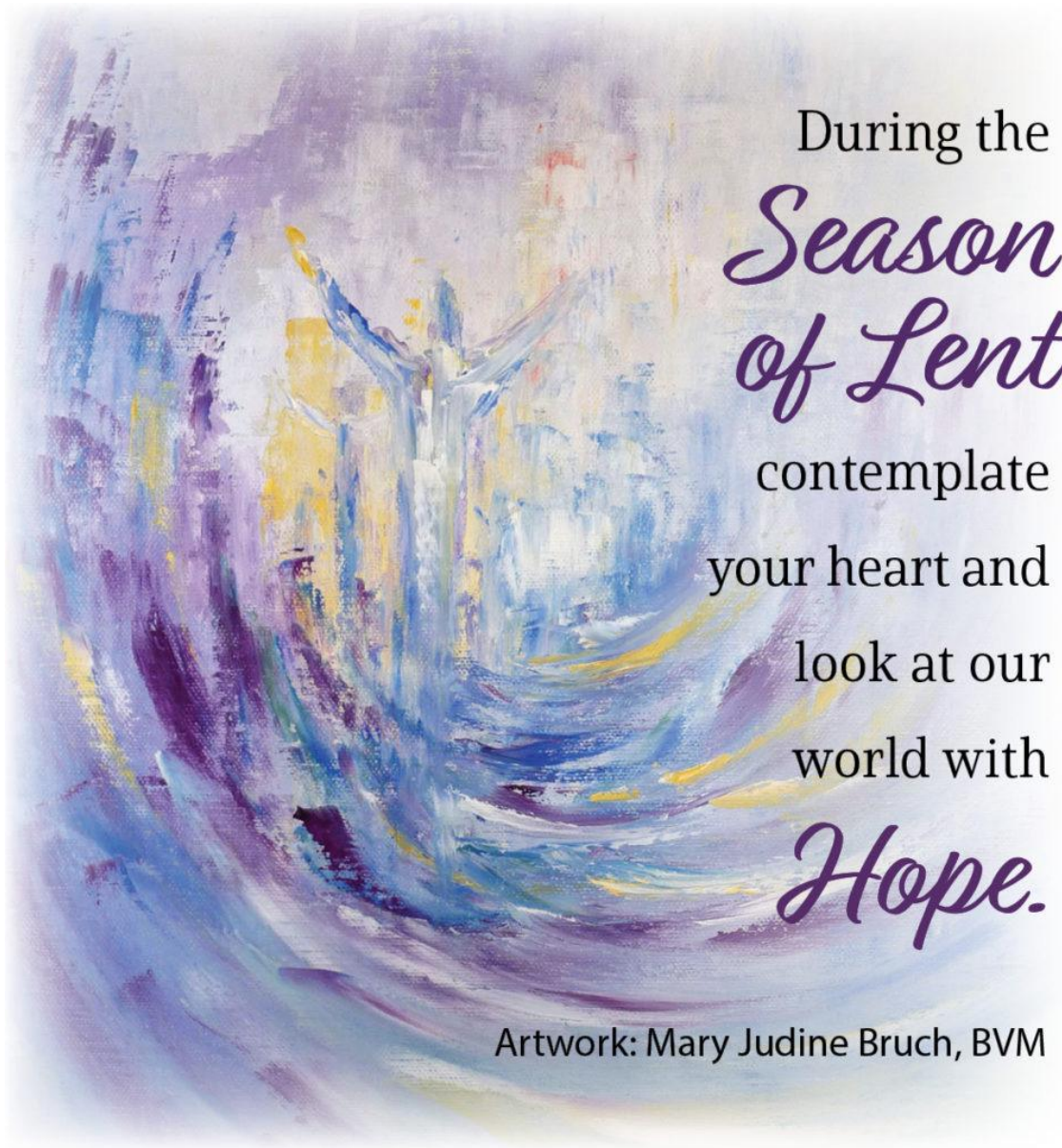

Scripture: Exodus 40:16-38 (Paraphrased) **Lay Readers:** Youth Readers

Moses did everything as the Lord commanded him. So the tabernacle was set up on the first day of the first month in the second year. Once Moses had set up the tabernacle, he took the Testimony and placed it in the ark and then placed the atonement cover over it and brought the ark into the tabernacle. Moses placed a table in the tent of meeting and set out the bread on it before the Lord, and lamps throughout, and the gold altar with burning incense in front of the curtain at the entrance as commanded. Moses put the basin between the tent of meeting and the altar and put

water in it for washing, and Moses and Aaron and his sons used it to wash their hands and feet anytime they entered the tent of meeting or approached the altar. Then Moses setup the courtyard around the tabernacle and altar and put up another curtain at the entrance to the courtyard and so Moses finished the work. Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle. In all of their travels whenever the cloud lifted the Israelites would set out so the cloud of the Lord was over the tabernacle by day and fire was in the cloud by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel during their journey to the promised land.
